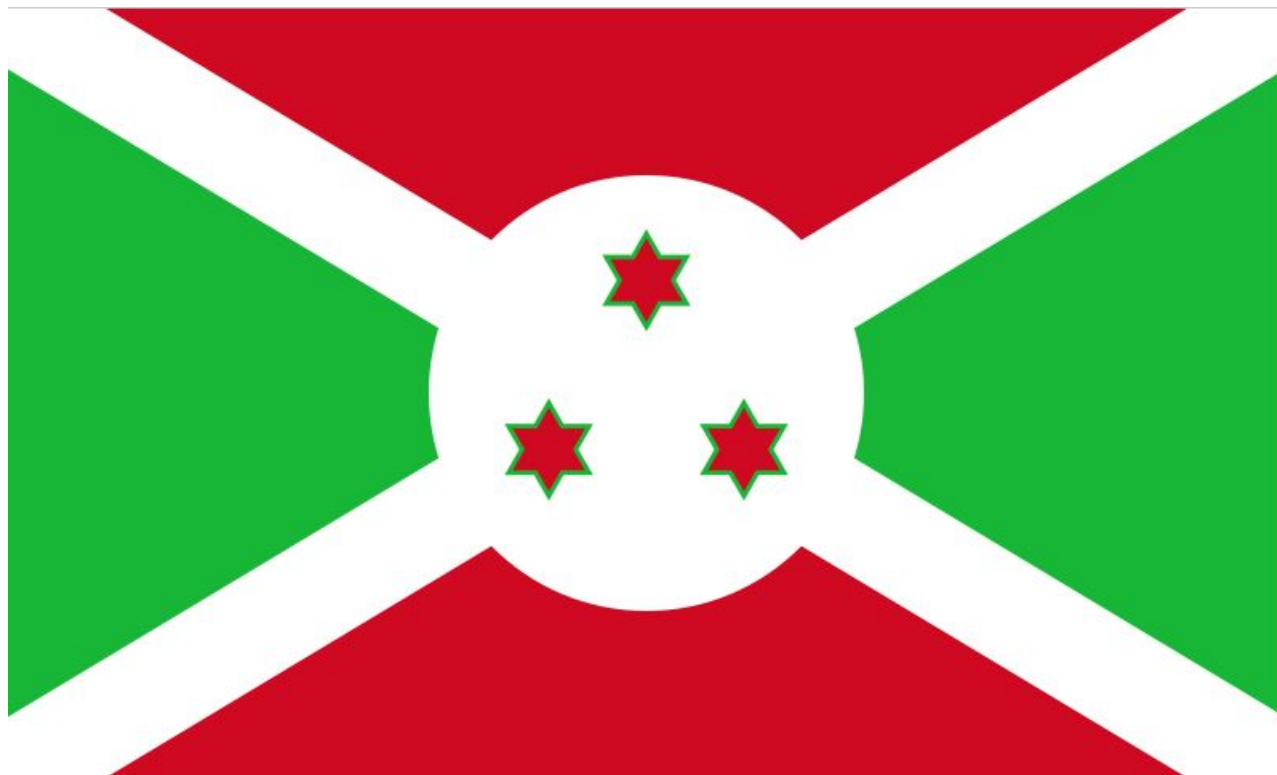


# Statement by the Secretary-General of the OACPS on the Presidential Elections in the Republic of Burundi
