STATEMENT BY THE ACP SECRETARY GENERAL ON THE TERROR ATTACKS IN MALI

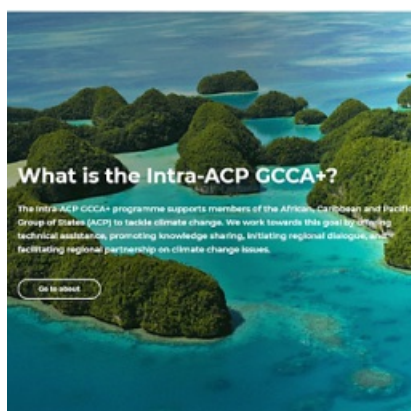
