107 ACP-EU Countries Walk The Talk On Global Governance

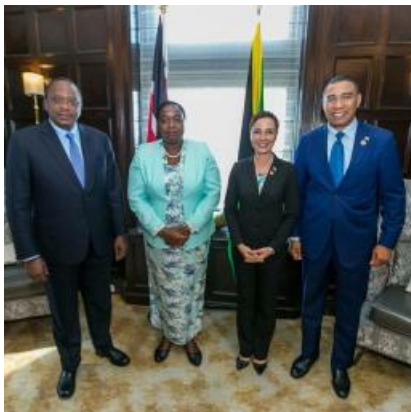
